

Time for ordering review extended on the court's own motion
The time for granting review on the court's own motion is hereby extended to December 10, 2015. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.512(c).)

Extension of time granted
On application of amicus curiae, Division of Labor Standards Enforcement, and good cause appearing, it is ordered that the time to serve and file the amicus curiae brief is extended to October 19, 2015. No further extensions will be contemplated.

Extension of time granted
On application of respondent and good cause appearing, it is ordered that the time to serve and file the informal response is extended to November 2, 2015.

Order filed

The “Application for Release of Files, Records, and any Confidential Materials,” filed on September 15, 2015, is granted. Counsel for Paul Palalaua Tuilaepa, the Federal Public Defender for the Central District of California, is granted access to the materials in the records of *People v.
