Second Appellate District Announces Destruction of Court Records

LOS ANGELES—The Court of Appeal for the <u>Second Appellate District</u> (Los Angeles) has announced its intention to destroy the following criminal, civil, and juvenile records in accordance with Rule 10.1 028(c)(2) of the California Rules of Court.

The records to be destroyed include criminal cases numbered up to B059999 with a final disposition prior to January 1, 1993 and civil and juvenile cases numbered up to B149999, with disposition date prior January 1, 2003.
