Sixth Appellate District Announces Destruction of Old Court Records

San Jose—The Court of Appeal for the Sixth Appellate District (San Jose) has announced its intention to destroy the following criminal, juvenile, and civil records pursuant to Rule 10.1028(c), California Rules of Court:

- All criminal and juvenile cases (excluding those with published opinions) designated in records transfer lists 35 and 37 encompassing criminal and juvenile cases preserved for a period longer than 20 years.
- All civil cases (excluding those with published opinions) designated in records transfer list 82 encompassing civil cases preserved for a period longer than 10 years.
