APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO JOIN BRIEF OF AMICI CURIAE

To the Honorable Chief Justice and Associate Justices:

This Application is brought on behalf of a coalition of diverse national, regional, statewide, and local religious and faith organizations, as well as individual clergy and faith leaders from across California, seeking to lend their voices in opposition to Proposition 8 and in support of Petitioners by joining an amicus brief already on file in this proceeding. By submitting this Application, these organizations and individuals hope to lend strength in numbers to the objections and concerns that religious groups have already described to the Court and to demonstrate that the vocal religious proponents of Proposition 8 do not speak for all of, or even most of, the faith-based community in California.

Applicants are fifteen national and international faith organizations, fourteen statewide and regional faith organizations, over 160 local congregations and faith organizations in California, and almost 700 California clergy and faith leaders (collectively, "Joining Amici"). They respectfully request permission of this Court to join the brief of Amici Curiae California Council of Churches; The Right Reverend Marc Handley Andrus, Episcopal Bishop of California; The Right Reverend J. John Bruno, Episcopal Bishop of Los Angeles; The General Synod of the United Church of Christ; Northern California Nevada Conference of the United Church of Christ; Southern California Nevada Conference of the United Church of Christ; Progressive Jewish Alliance; Unitarian Universalist Association of Congregations; and the Unitarian Universalist Legislative

Ministry California (“Faith Community Amici”) in support of Petitioners (the “Faith Community Amicus Brief”).

IDENTITY AND INTERESTS OF JOINING AMICI

Joining Amici come from a wide variety of faith traditions, among them the Jewish, Buddhist, Muslim, Catholic, Protestant (including United Church of Christ, Presbyterian, Episcopalian, Lutheran, and United Methodist), non-denominational Christian, Mormon, Seventh-day Adventist, Unitarian Universalist, and Quaker faiths. Some Joining Amici are national associations or communities with strong ties to California. Others are regional or statewide conferences and councils encompassing California. Still other Joining Amici are local religious communities or congregations. And hundreds of California’s clergy and faith leaders—including several of California’s most esteemed religious leaders—are also among Joining Amici.

A complete list of Joining Amici is attached as an Appendix.

GENERAL INTERESTS OF ALL JOINING AMICI

Joining Amici believe that same-sex couples should be afforded the same fundamental right as different-sex couples to participate in the State-sanctioned institution of marriage. Joining Amici submit the attached Application to demonstrate that the support for same-sex marriage is both broad and deep within and among California’s faith traditions, and also that permitting equal access to the marriage rite is a fundamental tenet of these faith traditions, and of their leaders, from every part of California. Further,

Joining Amici firmly believe that there are sound theological reasons supporting and even mandating that marriage should be available to same- and different-sex couples alike.

Joining Amici also have a profound interest in these proceedings. Like the Faith Community Amici, Joining Amici and their members count on the protection of article I, section 7 of the California Constitution, which guarantees equal protection of the laws without discrimination based on religion. But this constitutional guarantee of equal protection would be rendered a dead letter if Proposition 8 is given effect, for then a majority of the people may deprive any disfavored minority—whether it be, as here, a sexual minority, or in the future a religious minority—of inalienable rights by simple majority vote by ballot initiative. This result would thus bring to an end Joining Amici’s reliance on article I, section 7 as protection against the “tyranny of the majority”¹ and “the violence of majority faction,”² and instead begin a new period of uncertainty for minority groups in California.

Accordingly, Joining Amici seek to join the Faith Community Amici in seeking this Court’s invalidation of Proposition 8 because of the fear that a contrary ruling would negate California Constitution’s article I, section 7, clearing the way for an initiative-based selective deprivation of equal protection against minorities, including religious minorities. Joining Amici believe that the Court must be resolute against enabling such a selective deprivation of equal protection.

SPECIFIC INTERESTS OF SAMPLE APPLICANTS

A. Interest Statements of National Faith Organizations

DignityUSA: For 40 years, DignityUSA has been the nation's foremost organization of gay and lesbian Catholics, their families, friends, and supporters. DignityUSA works for respect and justice for all lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender persons in the Catholic Church and the world through education, advocacy and support. Currently, DignityUSA has approximately four thousand members, and forty-five chapters throughout the United States. Though the hierarchy of the Catholic Church has not endorsed marriage ceremonies between individuals of the same sex, most polls show that the majority of American Catholics support equal rights for same-sex couples. DignityUSA believes that gay and lesbian Catholics, like all people, retain an inherent dignity because God created us, Christ died for us, and the Holy Spirit sanctified us in Baptism, making us temples of the Spirit, and channels through which God's love becomes visible. Unequivocally then, DignityUSA supports the rights of same-sex couples to enter into marriages in a manner that is consonant with Christ's teachings and Christian values.

Integrity USA: Since 1974, Integrity has been a faithful witness of God's inclusive love to the Episcopal Church and the lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender community. Currently, Integrity USA has approximately 2,000 members, 80 parish partners, 35 diocesan networks, and 50 local chapters throughout the United States. Integrity USA is working for the full inclusion of all the baptized in all the sacraments of the Episcopal Church—including equal access to the sacrament of marriage by

same-gender couples. Although the Episcopal Church as a whole has not reached consensus on sacramental marriage for same-gender couples, our denomination is unequivocally supportive of civil marriage between two adults of the same gender. The 2006 General Convention of the Episcopal Church passed resolution A095, which called upon “municipal councils, state legislatures and the United States Congress to approve measures giving gay and lesbian couples protection[s] such as: bereavement and family leave policies; health benefits; pension benefits; real-estate transfer tax benefits; and commitments to mutual support enjoyed by non-gay married couples” and opposing “any state or federal constitutional amendment that prohibits same-sex civil marriage or civil unions.” Last year, a number of Episcopal clergy performed same-gender marriages as agents of the State of California and many Episcopalians entered into lawful civil marriages in the State of California. Therefore, Integrity USA firmly supports the right of Californians to enter into same-gender civil marriages.

The Jewish Social Policy Action Network (“JSPAN”):

JSPAN is a membership organization of American Jews dedicated to protecting the Constitutional liberties and civil rights of Jews, other minorities, and the vulnerable in our society. For most of the last two thousand years, whether they lived in Christian or Moslem societies, Jews were a small religious minority victimized by prejudice and lacking sufficient political power to protect their rights.³ During the Holocaust, not

only Jews, but homosexuals, Gypsies and others were targeted for persecution and death at the hands of the Nazis. Perhaps because of their shared history as victimized outsiders, Jews have been especially sensitive to the plight of the lesbian and gay community as a discrete and insular minority within American society and throughout much of the world.

In a newly published authoritative work, Rabbi Rebecca Alpert notes that all major non-Orthodox Jewish groups are on record supporting civil marriage for same-sex couples, that advocating for the rights of gay men and lesbians to participate in religious wedding ceremonies has been an important part of the liberal Jewish agenda for the past decade, and that gay and lesbian Jews often want children and a place for those children to develop Jewish identities and connections, a “desire ... often connected to a wish to marry.”⁴ As one of many voices within the progressive Jewish community, JSPAN shares these views and is committed to making marriage under civil law available to consenting couples without regard to their sexual orientation or gender identity. Anything less would continue to relegate a distinct group of human beings to second class status without legal, political, moral or social justification.

Since its founding in 2003, JSPAN has filed numerous amicus curiae briefs in the federal and state courts dealing with the enforcement of fundamental rights, most recently before the United States Supreme Court in *Pleasant Grove City v. Sumnum* (No. 08-665), the Second Circuit Court of Appeals in *Cooper v. U.S. Postal Service* (No. 07-4826), and the Third Circuit Court of Appeals in *Busch v. Marple Newtown School Dist.* (No. 07-2967), all of which are pending decision.

More Light Presbyterians: More Light Presbyterians is a national non-profit religious educational organization chartered in the State of California and affiliated with the Presbyterian Church (USA). There are fifty Presbyterian churches affiliated with our network in the State of California.

More Light Presbyterians has been working to end discrimination against lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender people and their families in the Presbyterian Church (USA) and in civil society since 1974. During these 35 years, significant progress has been made toward the understanding that persons do not choose their sexual orientation, that discrimination in civil society is wrong, and that Presbyterian pastors should be permitted to offer blessings of same-sex couples.

Since 1978, the Presbyterian Church (USA) has denounced discrimination against lesbian and gay persons in civil society. This official national non-discrimination in civil life policy has been reaffirmed in subsequent years and the Presbyterian Church (USA) has also affirmed the right and choice for its ministers to perform blessings of same-sex couples.

In June, 2008, the 218th General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (USA), meeting in San Jose, California, removed the anti-gay church policy statements from 1978 and passed an overture calling for the end to discrimination against lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender Presbyterians in membership and service in ministry within the Presbyterian Church (USA).

Presbyterians have a long history of social justice and working to end discrimination in every form. We believe that every person has the right to be part of a family and to be part of the faith community of their choice. By denying civil marriage, Proposition 8 denies that right and full experience to lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender Californians to be part of the family of their choice. Proposition 8 also denies the right and choice of Presbyterian ministers to extend the pastoral care of blessing same-sex couples through marriage. Proposition 8 casts doubt on the potential and real moral fitness of same-gender loving people and renders LGBT persons in the State of California as second-class citizens. Proposition 8 puts children and families at risk which is a deep concern for those of us in the faith community. Accordingly, More Light Presbyterians respectfully requests that the California State Supreme Court honor the inalienable rights of person, love and family and reject Proposition 8.

Muslims for Progressive Values: Muslims for Progressive Values believes that sexuality is a core component of human nature and sexual activity is an essential aspect of human lives. Yet the Qur'an states that God sanctions sexual activity only in the context of publicly acknowledged, committed relationships. Denying same-sex couples a

means to satisfy the command of the Qur'an is tantamount to demanding they commit a major sin or remain celibate their entire lives, neither of which is acceptable.

Muslims for Progressive Values believes that each individual should be free to navigate his or her own life path, so long as his or her choices do not harm other individuals. Thus, regardless of the views that other people might hold toward marriage or homosexuality, what is important is the view of the two individuals desiring to be married. It is morally wrong to prevent two committed adults from marrying each other just because they are of the same sex.

Aside from the moral ramifications of denying marriage to same-sex couples, denying marriage to same-sex couples puts one segment of our society at a financial and social disadvantage compared to other American citizens.

New Ways Ministry: Since 1977, New Ways Ministry has worked within Catholic Church structures and institutions to promote justice and reconciliation between lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (“LGBT”) Catholics, their families, and the wider Catholic community. New Ways Ministry promotes the full equality of LGBT people in church and society. We work toward this end by providing resources and programs that provide the most current scientific and theological understandings of sexuality and sexual orientation. Though not a membership organization, New Ways Ministry has a mailing constituency of over 4,000 Catholic individuals and organizations which include hundreds of parishes, scores of

Catholic colleges and universities, dozens of leaders of communities of priests and nuns, and innumerable pastoral ministers and volunteers. Although the hierarchy of the Catholic Church does not yet approve of same-sex marriage, New Ways Ministry's constituents believe that our church's social justice tradition, which promotes the equality and human rights of all people, compels us to work for full equal rights for same-sex couples in committed relationships.

The Union for Reform Judaism ("URJ"): The URJ, founded in 1873, is the central body of the Reform Movement in North America. The URJ is comprised of 900 congregations encompassing 1.5 million Reform Jews, organized through a regional structure including the Pacific Central West and Pacific Southwest Council, each of which includes congregations in California.

The URJ comes to this issue out of our obligation to ensure equality for all of God's children, regardless of sexual orientation. As Jews, we are taught in the very beginning of the Torah that God created humans *B'tselem Elohim*, in the Divine Image, and therefore the diversity of creation represents the vastness of the Eternal (Genesis 1:27). We oppose discrimination against all individuals, including gays and lesbians, for the stamp of the Divine is present in each and every human being. Thus, the Union and its regional councils in California unequivocally support equal rights for all people, including the right to a civil marriage license. Furthermore, we whole-heartedly reject the notion that the state should discriminate against gays and lesbians with regard to civil marriage equality out of deference to religious tradition, as Reform Judaism celebrates the

unions of loving same-sex couples and considers such partnerships worthy of blessing through Jewish ritual.

B. Interest Statements of Regional And Statewide Religious Organizations

California Faith for Equality: California Faith for Equality is a coalition of clergy and lay leaders of faith communities throughout California who have come together to focus the voice of communities of faith who support equality for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender people. Although civil marriage is a distinctly secular institution, the general public thinks of marriage as primarily a religious issue. The clergy and lay leaders of California Faith for Equality believe that people of faith have a duty to speak out against injustice and inequality and to affirm love between couples and in families. That is why California Faith for Equality urges this Court to support the right of gays and lesbians to marry the adult partner of their choosing on an equal basis with heterosexuals.

The Friends Committee on Legislation of California (“FCL”): FCL is a non-profit action group (established by Quakers in 1952) that works to bring more compassion and social justice into government by influencing law-making in the State Capitol. As a “lobby of conscience,” FCL is charged with reminding legislators of the worth of every person, regardless of social standing, sexual orientation, ethnic, or religious background.

The policies that guide the Friends Committee on Legislation are based on the Quaker beliefs that there is that of God in every person,

that each person is endowed with worth and dignity and that the social, economic and political aspects of life should be conducted with utmost concern for the individual. FCL's legislative policy statements state that "no individual should be denied opportunity on the basis of class or group characteristics," including sexual orientation. Accordingly, FCL believes that the right to enter into the institution of civil marriage should not be denied to same-sex individuals.

In addition to promoting equality, FCL viewed the issue as one of religious freedom. Historically, Quaker Meetings have experienced tension between religious ceremony and the civil authorities as a result of not having traditional religious clergy. In its ruling in *In re Marriage Cases*, the state resolved that tension by becoming neutral and not favoring the views of some religious organizations over others on the issue of same-sex marriage. The Quaker Meetings that perform same-sex marriages are experiencing that tension once again because of Proposition 8. Not only does Proposition 8 enshrine discrimination in California's Constitution, contrary to Quaker principles and FCL policies, but it also represents a step back from the neutrality this Court achieved in its prior ruling. FCL strongly opposes that outcome.

Pacific Association of Reform Rabbis ("PARR"): PARR is a regional body representing approximately 250 Reform rabbis in the western region of the United States. The mission of its parent organization, the Central Conference of American Rabbis ("CCAR"), founded in 1889, is to enrich and strengthen the Jewish community by empowering Reform Rabbis to provide religious, spiritual and organizational leadership. CCAR

has advocated for equality and justice for all throughout its history, based on its theology that every human being, equally created in the divine image, is fundamentally equal and entitled to dignity, equality and justice. The CCAR has formally and publicly supported the right of gay and lesbian couples to share fully and equally in civil marriage since 1996. PARR is committed to marriage equality as a matter of religious conscience and as a matter of protecting the religious freedom of its members who feel called by God to honor the diversity of God's creation by treating same gender couples and opposite gender couples equally.

C. Interest Statements of Clergy and Local Congregations

Rabbi Linda Bertenthal, Co-Acting Regional Director, Pacific Central West Council, and Senior Associate Director, Pacific Southwest Council, Union for Reform Judaism: The Reform Movement's theology embraces the Torah's teaching that all humans, in all our diversity, are equally created in the image of God, and derives from this teaching a commitment to advocating for equality for all. The Torah also teaches that it is not good for a human being to be alone—that we are created to be in relationship and live most fully and authentically when we engage in relationship. To bar any human being from marriage, the relationship in which we most deeply reveal our true selves and nurture one another, would not only cruelly harm that particular human being, but would also denigrate a portion of God's creation and render the institution of marriage less holy by virtue of being less wholly reflective of God's image. Such a bar would force me as a Rabbi to make the impossible choice of violating God's call either by refusing to participate in the

creation of marriages or by engaging in discrimination by marrying only opposite-gender couples. As a Jew who is married, such a bar undermines the sanctity of my own marriage by making the institution of marriage a discriminatory institution.

Senior Minister Kevin Bucy, Midtown Church, United Church of Religious Science, San Diego: In my years of working with people, first as a therapist and now as a minister, I have come to realize it is most commonly love that motivates people to create family. This is no less true for gay and lesbian people. To allow same-sex individuals the right to marry gives them the structure and protection for their families that non-gay people enjoy. Denying same-sex couples the right to marry lessens their rights in society, which is discriminatory.

For a government to choose the beliefs of one religious organization over another and create laws that apply to all Americans based on those religious beliefs undermines the meaning of freedom our Country was founded upon. Throughout our Country, there are spiritual communities that believe all are created in the image of their Creator, regardless of orientation, nationality, or belief. In our land, there are faithful people who believe God is love and where there is love, God is expressing regardless of who is in love with whom.

Allowing same-sex marriage would eliminate the pain and injustice of discrimination; it would not allow certain people to choose what is right and what is wrong for others; it would support and protect

non-traditional families. Allowing same-sex marriage would uphold the freedom our Country was founded upon.

Rabbi Elliot Dorff, American Jewish University and Conservative Rabbi: Of the three major movements in American Judaism, Conservative Judaism is the middle movement and the one in which the status of gays and lesbians in Jewish law has been most heatedly debated. Even those adherents to Conservative Judaism who have difficulty reconciling the performance of a religious marriage ceremony for gays or lesbians with Leviticus 18:22, however, are strongly in favor of legalizing civil marriage for same-sex couples as a matter of individual American rights. The rabbinic and synagogue organizations of the Movement have adopted resolutions to this effect.

In addition, as a religious minority in America, many Jews—Conservative Jews among them—have experienced past discrimination and therefore depend on the constitutional guarantees of equal protection to guard against such discrimination in the future. If Proposition 8 is upheld, it would begin a new period of uncertainty for minority groups in California, one where a simple majority vote can overrun minority rights. I firmly believe that the Court must stand resolute against enabling the selective deprivation of equal protection by the tyranny of the majority.

Bishop Brenda D. Evans Cooper, Christ Chapel of North Park, San Diego: Christ Chapel, an Independent Full Gospel Non Denominational Christian Church, is a very diverse congregation, made up of all walks of life, which further embraces equal rights for all people. We

have always performed marriages/unions for same-sex committed couples since our conception. We hope that equal rights for all people in America would be legally recognized in every state and especially within our own state, California. Christ Chapel has lived and witnessed many unfair acts because of our belief and despair that many same-sex relationships—although strong and faithful for many years—have been denied access to equal rights solely based on the fears of some or religious interpretations of others. Christ Chapel of North Park stands firm on its position as to same-sex marriages as it does with every other discriminative act against equality. Thus, Christ Chapel strongly supports the right of same-sex couples to marry.

Pastor Dr. Robert Goldstein, St. Francis Lutheran Church, San Francisco: St. Francis Lutheran Church was founded in 1898, survived the earthquake of 1906, and served as a temporary infirmary for the wounded. In the 1970s St. Francis founded a childcare center for children with family members in prison. Today this center provides high quality education and support for low-income children and families. The St. Francis Senior Center, also founded in the 1970s, provides hot meals, social activities, legal referrals, education, and support for elders. In the 1980s the congregation responded to the emerging AIDS crisis in San Francisco with a wide array of services and networking support with local hospice services. In the 1990s the congregation openly challenged the policies of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) prohibiting openly gay and lesbian persons in committed, covenanted relationships from serving in pastoral ministry. At this very moment the ELCA is on the verge

of catching up to St. Francis on married gay and lesbian clergy serving its congregations. Across the years the congregation has also supported the only ministry to gay and lesbian persons in Capetown, South Africa. In the 2000s the congregation provides outreach to the homeless, providing hospitality and a break every Sunday.

St. Francis Lutheran Church continues to work for marriage equality in church and society. The decision of the Supreme Court of California affirming the equality of rights for both heterosexual and homosexual couples to marry was welcomed by St. Francis as consistent with our vision of a just society. We realize that marriage equality does not require any church to marry gay and lesbian couples, but it does allow gay and lesbian couples to get married and have the same rights and benefits of non-gay couples. St. Francis affirms the value to society of all committed relationships and affirms that same-sex couples and different-sex couples should stand equally under the law and have the same rights and responsibilities. To this end it was a great disservice to justice that Proposition 8 was voted into the constitution for it sets a precedent of eroding equal protection guarantees that all minorities, including religious minorities, rely on to protect against discriminatory action by the majority.

Reverend Kathy Huff, First Unitarian Church, Oakland:

As a member of the clergy I have the authority to sign marriage certificates and help make legal what is in practice an unjust law. For this reason and as an act of solidarity with same-sex couples who are prohibited from making their committed relationships legal, I no longer sign marriage licenses. As a minister serving congregations whose membership includes many same-sex

couples in committed relationships I have witnessed the ways marriage laws prevent these couples from living out the many freedoms that legally married couples enjoy. As a person of faith, I cannot in good conscience support laws that selectively bestow rights and privileges on couples after they have declared their commitment to one another. Some argue this is a "moral" or "religious" issue, not just a legal one. I agree. It is immoral to discriminate against any of our citizens. When the state forces me to choose between officiating ceremonies between same-sex couples and different sex couples, it is also prohibiting me from exercising my full freedom to practice my religion. As a Unitarian Universalist my faith calls on me to stand firmly on the side of love and to say no to discrimination and oppression in all its forms. To suggest through omission that same sex couples are any less committed or any less deserving of the rights of heterosexual couples is to ask me to violate some of the core values that shape my religious tradition. These values are the same ones that I have always believed were intended to shape our public life—those of life, liberty and justice for all. That same-sex couples continue to be denied the basic human rights that others take for granted goes against these principles.

Julius Nam, Ph.D., Associate Professor of Religion at Loma Linda University School of Religion: I am Associate Professor of Religion at the Loma Linda University School of Religion. Loma Linda University is a health sciences university operated by the Seventh-day Adventist Church, a worldwide Protestant denomination of more than 15 million members.

Same-sex marriages ought to be legal in the State of California because that would lead to a more just, fair, and righteous society. I concur with the decision made by the Supreme Court in May 2008 that there ought not to be two different names—marriage and domestic partnership—for the identical contractual and covenantal relationship into which two individuals may enter and receive the recognition, benefits, entitlements and responsibilities accorded by the State. As a Christian minister, commissioned by the Seventh-day Adventist Church, restricting “marriage” to heterosexual unions serves neither the cause of God nor the overall intent of Scripture. Throughout the Old and New Testaments of the Christian Scripture, I see God leading humanity to a deeper and fuller understanding of righteousness. Jesus exemplified the fullest and brightest meaning of righteousness through the way he related with oppressed and subjugated minorities, including women, children, slaves, and foreigners. Jesus invited all people into a new way of egalitarian living in which there was “neither Jew nor Greek, male nor female, slave nor free,” as Apostle Paul summarized. This is also the principle upon which California stands, and it ought to extend to the way gays and lesbians are treated in society and how we as a society regard and sanction the unions they enter into. I believe God blesses every exclusive, committed, and permanent covenantal relationship—whether homosexual or heterosexual—as marriage, and the State ought to also recognize it as such. When the fundamental rights and privileges of “marriage” extend to and include same-sex unions, I believe California would become an even more just, fair and righteous society.

The Seventh-day Adventist Church does not believe that homosexuality and same-sex marriages are sanctioned by God. In fact, the Seventh-day Adventist Church State Council in California supported Proposition 8 and submitted an amicus brief in favor of it. But I, along with five others who disagree with the church's position, have led a public petition drive against Proposition 8 and the church's support of it (<http://adventistsagainstprop8.org>). While I write as an individual and not as a representative of either the Seventh-day Adventist Church or Loma Linda University, at the same time, I also note that the church's support of Proposition 8 does not represent the attitude of a significant number of Adventist residents of California.

THE REASONS FOR ALLOWING APPLICANTS TO JOIN THE BRIEF ON FILE

Joining Amici are familiar with the questions involved in this case and believe that the Faith Community Amicus Brief fairly addresses those issues from the perspective of the faith community. Like the Faith Community Amici, Joining Amici are religious organizations, other faith communities and associations, and clergy that believe strongly in the rights of same-sex couples to participate in State-sanctioned marriage and further agree with the points made in the Faith Community Amicus Brief. Given the unique perspective of the faith community on the issues before the Court, Joining Amici wish to join the arguments presented in the Faith Community Amicus Brief, which the Court accepted for filing on January 14, 2009. Joining Amici do not wish to alter the brief in any way.

For these reasons, Joining Amici respectfully request that the Court allow it to join the brief of Amici Curiae California Council of Churches; The Right Reverend Marc Handley Andrus, Episcopal Bishop of California; The Right Reverend J. John Bruno, Episcopal Bishop of Los Angeles; The General Synod of the United Church of Christ; Northern California Nevada Conference of the United Church of Christ; Southern California Nevada Conference of the United Church of Christ; Progressive Jewish Alliance; Unitarian Universalist Association of Congregations; and the Unitarian Universalist Legislative Ministry California.
