## Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions for Week of May 13, 2013

*[This news release is issued to inform the public and the press of cases that the Supreme Court has accepted and of their general subject matter. The statement of the issue or issues in each case set out below does not necessarily reflect the view of the court, or define the specific issues that will be addressed by the court.]*

**#13-43 *Conservatorship of McQueen, S209376.*** (A134337; nonpublished opinion; Alameda County Superior Court; HP05237122.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed an order granting a motion for post-judgment attorney fees and costs. This case presents the following issue: Is a trial court award of statutorily-mandated fees and costs incurred on appeal subject to the Enforcement of Judgments Statutes (Code Civ. Proc., § 685.040 et seq.) if the statutory authority underlying the award is the Elder Abuse Act (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 15600 et seq.)?

**#13-44 *People v. Powell, S210044.*** (G046265; 214 Cal.App.4th 106; Orange County Superior Court; 10HF1992.) Review on the court's own motion after the Court of Appeal reversed a judgment of conviction of a criminal offense. The court ordered briefing deferred pending decision in *People v. Williams, S195187* (#11-122), which presents the following issue: Can a conviction for robbery be based on the use of force in the attempt to escape after committing the crime of theft by false pretenses as opposed to theft by larceny?
