Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions for Week of August 27, 2012

[This news release is issued to inform the public about cases that the California Supreme Court has accepted, their general subject matter, and related actions. The statement of the issue or issues in each case does not necessarily reflect the view of the court or define the specific issues that will be addressed by the court.]

#12-92 *In re Marriage of Green, S203561.* (A129436; 205 Cal.App.4th 1475, mod. 206 Cal.App.4th 548a; Contra Costa County Superior Court; D0801292.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed the judgment in a marital dissolution action. This case presents the following issue: Did the Court of Appeal err in concluding that one spouse's four years of CalPERS service credits, which were purchased partly with community funds and were based on his military service before the marriage, were not entirely his separate property and had to be allocated between community and separate property?

#12-93 *People v. Mason, S203747.* (H036598; 206 Cal.App.4th 1026; Santa Clara County Superior Court; EE806813.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal affirmed a judgment of conviction of a criminal offense. The court ordered briefing deferred pending decision in *People v. McCullough, S192513* (#11-80), which presents the following issue: Did defendant forfeit his claim that he was unable to pay the \$270.17 jail booking fee (Gov. Code, § 29550.2) imposed by the trial court at sentencing, because he failed to object at the time?
