Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions for Week of September 2, 2013

#13-76 Federated University Police Officers Assn. v. Superior Court, S213024. (A136014; 218 Cal.App.4th 18; Alameda County Superior Court; RG12632350.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal denied a petition for writ of mandate. The court ordered briefing deferred pending decision in Long Beach Police Officers Assn. v. City of Long Beach, S200872 (#12-41), which presents the following issue: Are the names of police officers involved in on-duty shooting incidents subject to disclosure under the California Public Records Act?
