APPEAL from orders of the Superior Court of San Diego County, David B. Oberholtzer, Judge. Dismissed.

M.P. appeals orders entered at a jurisdictional and dispositional hearing held pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code sections 300, subdivision (b), and 361. Citing *In re Sade C.* (1996) 13 Cal.4th 952, she asks this court to exercise its discretion to review the record for error.

In *In re Sade C.*, the California Supreme Court held that review pursuant to *People v. Wende* (1979) 25 Cal.3d 436 is unavailable in "an indigent parent's appeal from a judgment or order, obtained by the state, adversely affecting his [or her] custody of a child or his [or her] status as the child's parent." (*In re Sade C.*, *supra*, 13 Cal.4th at p. 959.) We therefore deny M.P.'s requests to review the record for error and to address the *Anders* issues. (*Anders v. California* (1967) 386 U.S. 738.)

Citing *In re Phoenix H.* (2009) 47 Cal.4th 835, M.P.'s counsel requests leave for her client to file a supplemental brief in propria persona, and also asks this court to order counsel to brief any arguable issue. (*Penson v. Ohio* (1988) 488 U.S. 75, 88.) The requests are denied.

#### DISPOSITION

The appeal is dismissed.
