

Request to Release Driver's License Suspension (Non-Payment of Child Support)

Step 1	<p>Notify: You must first contact the Santa Clara County Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) and ask if your license can be released without a court hearing. They are open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday at:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">880 Ridder Park Drive, San Jose, CA 95131 1-866-901-3212</p>
Step 2	<p>Complete the following forms in blue or black ink: <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> FL-670 Notice of Motion for Judicial Review of License Denial</p>
Step 3	<p>Copies: Make <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> 3 copies, in addition to the original.</p>
Step 4 <i>This is FREE to file.</i>	<p>File: Turn in the original and copies to the Clerk's Office in the Courthouse located at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 170 Park Avenue, San Jose, CA • 99 Notre Dame Ave., San Jose, CA • 605 W. El Camino Real, Sunnyvale, CA • 301 Diana Ave., Morgan Hill, CA <p><i>Monday-Friday from 8:30am to 4:00pm.</i></p>
Step 5	<p>Service:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must serve a copy on the Department of Child Support Services. Bring one copy to the Self-Help Center at the Notre Dame Courthouse. We will serve it on DCSS and complete and file a Proof of Service showing that DCSS was served with your form. • You must also serve a copy by mail on the other parent. "Service by mail" means: someone other than you who is at least 18 years old must mail the filed copies to the other parent. This should be done the same day that you file your paperwork with the Court. <p>Whoever does the service must complete the attached <i>Proof of Service by Mail form</i> (FL-335) and give it back to you. You must file the original and a copy of this form at the Clerk's Office, the clerk will file stamp the copy and give it back to you. Keep this copy for your records.</p>
Step 6	<p>Go to the hearing:</p> <p>Do not forget to go to court for your hearing at the date and time written on your Notice of Motion for Judicial Review of License Denial.</p>
