## Court Receives Victim Restitution Establishment Request (ACC801)

### Exchange Description

A trial court uses this NIEM-based data exchange to receive a victim restitution establishment request from an integration partner and to create a victim restitution account in the court system. Integration partners use this data exchange to send a request to a court to create a victim restitution establishment account.

- The request message from the integration partner contains the victim restitution establishment case information (e.g., CCMS case number, participant, etc.).
- The response message from the trial court contains the victim restitution information.

### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- Court Sends Victim Restitution Establishment Request (ACC904) confirms the initial request successfully passed the clerk review and contains the pertinent restitution information.
- Court Sends Clerk Review Rejection Notification (EFL902) contains rejection information in response to the court clerk's review of the initial filing.

### Error Handling

If an integration partner does not successfully receive and process the request message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

## RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are any preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Payment Notification (FCC806), which is used to receive any type of case payment from an integration partner

### **Additional Information**

- A single exchange message is sent for each victim restitution establishment request.
- This exchange is subject to the clerk review process, which requires that court personnel review the contents of the exchange before it is accepted and added into CCMS. The content of the response message is defined using a different exchange, listed in the Business Response Exchanges section above.
