## Court Sends Cash Bail Confirmation Notification (ACC905)

### Exchange Description

Trial courts use this NIEM-based data exchange to send an acceptance response to the cash bail request to the integration partner. This exchange is the business response to the Receive Cash Bail Notification (ACC802) data exchange.

- The notification message contains the cash bail confirmation (e.g., CCMS case number, participant, cash bail case information, etc.).
- No response message is sent by the integration partner upon successful receipt of the request message. Successful delivery of the request message is assumed unless an error in delivery or processing by the integration partner occurs.

### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There are no business responses to this data exchange

### Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the request message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

- Attorney General

### RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are any preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Cash Bail Notification (ACC802) data exchange, which is used by a trial court to receive a cash bail notification filing from an integration partner.

### **Additional Information**

- A single exchange message is sent for each cash bail confirmation.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. The only allowable response to this exchange is an error message. The error response message must be sent as a separate message using the error format defined in this exchange.
