### Court Sends Bail Bond Confirmation Notification (ACC906)

#### Exchange Description

Trial courts use this NIEM-based data exchange to send a confirmation notification to the case initiation request received from the integration partner using the Court Receives Bail Bond Notification (ACC803) data exchange.

- The confirmation notification message from the trial court contains bail bond case information (e.g., CCMS case number, participant, etc.).
- No response message is sent by the integration partner upon successful receipt of the confirmation notification. Successful delivery of the confirmation message is assumed unless an error in delivery or processing by the integration partner occurs.

#### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There are no business responses to this data exchange.

#### Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the request message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

#### RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are any preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Bail Bond Notification (ACC803) enables the trial court to receive a request for a bail bond filing from an integration partner.

### **Additional Information**

- A single exchange message is sent for each bail bond confirmation.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. The only allowable response to this exchange is an error message. The error response message must be sent as a separate message using the error format defined in this exchange.
