## Court Sends Case Transfer to ACCMS Notification (APL901)

### Exchange Description

Trial courts use this California judicial branch XML schema-based data exchange to send a case transfer or subsequent document to an appellate court.

The trial court may use this data exchange when:

- A case participant files an appeal.
- A case participant is found guilty on a death sentence.
- An appellate court requests additional documentation from the trial court.

The notification message from the trial court contains the appeals packet/subsequent documents (e.g., CCMS case number, document type).

The response message contains receipt confirmation information (e.g., the CCMS case number and ACCMS case number).

### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There are no business responses to this data exchange.

### Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the request message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

## RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Order, Disposition Order, or Opinion Notification (ACCMS) (APL802) is used when the integration partner uses this data exchange to send an order, disposition order, or opinion notification to the trial court.
- Court Receives Remittitur Notification (ACCMS) (APL803) data exchange is used when the integration partner uses this data exchange to send a remittitur notification to the trial court.

### **Additional Information**

- A single message is sent for each case transfer notification.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. Both the success and the error response messages must be sent as separate messages using the formats defined in this exchange.
