Court Receives Case Search Query (APP801)

Exchange Description

Integration partners use this NIEM-based data exchange to request case listing information from the trial court. An integration partner may use this exchange to search trial court records for any additional cases for a specific participant.

- The request message from the integration partner contains the case search parameters (e.g., CCMS case number, participant name, and citation number).
- The response message from the trial court contains the search result. If the search is successful, the integration partner receives a message indicating whether any cases exist that match the search criteria. If cases do exist, basic case information is returned (e.g., CCMS case number, case initiation date, and participant information). If the search is unsuccessful and no cases exist, the integration partner receives an error response message containing a rejection indicator and reason.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There are no business responses to this data exchange.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the request message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

PROBABLE INTERESTED INTEGRATION PARTNERS

- City Attorney
- District attorney—adult and juvenile
- Electronic filing service provider
- Law enforcement agencies/sheriff
- Probation—adult and juvenile
- Public defender/alternate public defender/entity panel

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Case Summary Query (CAS801). An integration partner may use this data exchange to send a request for detailed case information to the trial court after using the Court Receives Case Search Query (APP801) exchange.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each search query request.
- The response message to this exchange is sent immediately upon receipt and processing by CCMS. The success response message contains case listing information. The error response informs the integration partner that an error was encountered and corrective action is required.
