Court Receives Calendar Event Request (CAL801)

Exchange Description

Integration partners use this NIEM-based data exchange to schedule an event with the trial court. It may also be used to schedule a reserved event or reserve an event (on a case).

This data exchange may be used when the integration partner wants to:

- Schedule a hearing for a defendant or minor in probation
- Obtain a calendar date, time, and location prior to releasing a defendant on an own recognizance
- Schedule a hearing for a probation client seeking modification to probation terms and conditions

The request message from the integration partner contains the calendar request information (e.g., participant, calendar event date and time, court location, courtroom event reason).

The response message from the trial court contains the event confirmation and includes the entire set of request data.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange, which may be one of the following:

- Court Sends Calendar Event Request Confirmation Notification (CAL904), which is used by the trial court to notify the integration partner of the scheduled event.
- Court Sends Clerk Review Rejection Notification (EFL902), which is used by the trial court to notify the integration partner of an error in the event request.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Sends Calendar Event Notification (CAL902), which the courts use to send a calendar event notification to an integration partner.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the request message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason. The Error Response message contains the error and error description and status information (e.g., “Rejected”). The Error Response message informs the integration partner that CCMS did not receive the request and the integration partner must resubmit the request after correcting the errors in the request. Integration partners must receive the Success Response message before the court clerk review can begin.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each calendar event request.
- This exchange is subject to the Clerk Review (CR) process. The Success Response message contains delivery confirmation data with status information (e.g., “Received”), along with the original request message echoed back to the sender. The Success Response message informs the integration partner that CCMS received the request, and the court clerk will perform a subsequent and separate review.
