Court Receives Case Calendar Information Query (CAL805)

Exchange Description

Integration partners use this NIEM-based data exchange to send a request for and receive case calendar information from the trial court.

This data exchange enables the integration partner to request:

- The next scheduled hearing for a specific case
- A list of hearings calendared on a specific case

The request message from the integration partner contains query request—case calendar information query parameters (e.g., case number or external case number).

The response message contains the query response—case calendar information query result (e.g., calendar type, event type, and status).

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There are no business responses to this data exchange.
- The query response is defined in the current exchange.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

- The response to this message is sent immediately upon receipt and processing by CCMS. If the response is not successful, an error message is returned, which is sent as a separate message using the error format defined in this exchange.
