Court Receives Public Defender Assignment Notification (CAS806)

Exchange Description

Integration partners use this NIEM-based data exchange to send an updated attorney assignment to the trial court. This data exchange is used when the public defender or alternate public defender assigns or removes an attorney from a defendant's case. Specifically, the integration partner may use this data exchange to:

- Assign a new public defender or alternate public defender to a case
- Remove or end-date a public defender or alternate public defender from a case

The request message contains the public defender information (e.g., CCMS case number, participant, public defender attorney information).

The success response message contains delivery confirmation of the public defender assignment request (e.g., "received") and includes the contents of the request message.

Business Response Exchanges

The court clerk or judicial review process for this response is optional. The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- Court Sends Public Defender Assignment Confirmation Notification (CAS908) data exchange confirms the initial request successfully passed the clerk review and contains the pertinent public defender assignment information.
- Court Sends Clerk Review Rejection Notification (EFL902) exchange contains rejection information in response to the court clerk's review of the initial filing.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Sends Public Defender Case Assignment Notification (CAS904), which is used to send a public defender or alternate public defender case assignment notification to an integration partner when the public defender has been assigned to a case as a case resource by the trial court.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner receives an error message with an error code and error reason.

Additional Information

- An exchange message is sent for each notification.
- The business response message is defined in a different exchange, listed above in the Business Response Exchanges section.
- The business response to this exchange occurs only after completion of the optional clerk review (CR) or judicial review process. When the exchange is implemented for CR, there will always be two responses: (1) the success response (or error response), and (2) the business response, in this case CAS908, or EFL902 (clerk rejection).
- When CR is not implemented by the trial court, the response message, either success or error, to this exchange is sent immediately upon receipt and processing by CCMS. The integration partner will receive the business response (CAS908) only if they implement this exchange.
