Court Receives Case Notice List Query (CAS807)

Exchange Description

Integration partners use this NIEM-based data exchange to send a request to the trial court for the notice list for a court case. The response to this query request identifies the case participants that are selected to be on the notice list for any forms or notices to be generated by the trial court for the selected case.

- The request message from the integration partner contains the query request—case information (e. g., case number).
- The response message contains the case participants (e. g., participant ID, name, and address) selected to be on the notice list for any forms or notices generated on the case.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There are no business response exchanges to this exchange.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.
