## Purpose

The purpose of this document is to identify and explain the changes in California's Court Case Management System (CCMS) data exchanges as documented in *Version V4 Final 4.0* and *Version V4 Final 5.0* of the document *ISB and CCMS-V4 Data Exchanges Overview*. The *ISB and CCMS-V4 Data Exchanges Overview* is an overview of the Integration Services Backbone (ISB) architecture and the CCMS data exchanges as they relate to the CCMS core product.

*Version V4 Final 5.0* lists 121 data exchanges. The list of the 121 data exchanges in the *Version V4 Final 5.0* is the approved final list of data exchanges that will be built for CCMS. The previous version of this document, *Version V4 Final 4.0*, lists 125 data exchanges.

The difference in the total number of exchanges reflects the removal of 10, and the addition of six data exchanges, for a net reduction of two data exchanges. The changes and justifications were documented as part of the conditional approval of *Version V4 Final 4.0*. The resulting changes are reflected in *Version V4 Final 5.0*.
