Court Sends Abstract of Conviction Notification (DMV902)

Exchange Description

Trial courts use this California judicial branch XML schema-based data exchange to send an original or amended DMV abstract of conviction (DDI) to the California Department of Motor Vehicles. This exchange is the initial required report for convictions to be submitted to the DMV. It is also used to report Owner Responsibility convictions only, where no Failure to Appear (FTA) is involved.

- The notification message contains the abstract of conviction information (e.g., participant's driver's license number and sections violated) sent by the court to the DMV.
- The response message is sent by the DMV to the court upon successful receipt of the notification message and contains the abstract of conviction response (e.g., participant's driver license number, docket number, and message code).

This data exchange may be used when a case with reportable violations is adjudicated and/or an adjudicated case disposition is subsequently entered or amended.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There is no business response to this exchange.

Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Sends Failure to Pay Hold Notification (DMV904), which a court uses if a defendant fails to pay court ordered obligations.
- Court Sends Failure to Appear Hold Notification (DMV906), which a court uses if a defendant does not appear in court.
- Court Sends Failure to Comply Notification (DMV907), which a court uses if a defendant does not comply with a court order, or if the Failure to Comply order is released.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each abstract of conviction update request.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. Both the success and error response messages must be sent as separate messages using the formats defined in this exchange.
