Court Sends Failure to Pay Hold Notification (DMV904)

Exchange Description

Trial courts use this California judicial branch XML schema-based data exchange to send a failure to pay hold abstract (DD3) to the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). The court reports a person's violation of the requirement to pay the assessed fine relating to a court order, known as a Failure to Pay (FTP). Not all sentencing authorities allow for FTP reporting, depending upon the circumstances (e.g., any registration hold, owner responsibility cannot be sent). The grace period to report a FTP differs by court.

- The notification message contains the FTP hold abstract information (e.g., participant's driver license number and sections violated).
- The response message is sent by the DMV upon successful receipt of the notification message and contains the FTP hold abstract response (e.g., participant's driver's license number and message code).

The trial court may use this data exchange when a case participant is flagged for failure to pay as an outcome of the FTP enforcement process.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There is no business response to this exchange.

Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Sends Abstract of Conviction Notification (DMV902), which a court uses to report the initial conviction report to DMV, after which the court will use the FTP hold notification exchange.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each DMV failure to pay hold notification request.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. Both the success and error response messages must be sent as separate messages using the formats defined in this exchange.
