Court Receives Disposition Error Report Notification (DOJ802)

Exchange Description

The California Department of Justice (DOJ) uses this NIEM-based data exchange to send a disposition error report notification to the trial court. The DOJ can use this data exchange to notify the trial court of one or more errors from a previously submitted initial or amended disposition.

- The notification message contains the disposition error report information (e.g., error code and error message) sent by the DOJ to the trial court.
- No response message is sent by the trial court upon successful receipt of the notification message. Successful delivery of the notification message is assumed unless an error in delivery or processing by the trial court occurs.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There is no business response to this exchange.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Sends Initial Subsequent Disposition Notification (DOJ901), which is used by the trial court to send the initial disposition information and will be used to submit a subsequent disposition notification containing the error correction to the California Department of Justice.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each disposition error report notification request.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the trial court. The only allowable response to this exchange is an error message. The error response message must be sent as a separate message using the error format defined in this exchange.
