Court Sends Initial or Subsequent Disposition Notification (DOJ901)

Exchange Description

Trial courts use this NIEM-based data exchange to send an initial or subsequent disposition notification to the integration partner, California Department of Justice (DOJ). A trial court may use this data exchange to notify the DOJ when a disposition is entered or modified on an adult or juvenile case in CCMS.

- The notification message contains the initial or amended disposition information (e.g., arresting agency, FBI number) sent from a trial court to the DOJ.
- No response message is sent by the DOJ upon successful receipt of the notification message. Successful delivery of the notification message is assumed unless an error in delivery or processing by the DOJ occurs.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange, as follows:

- Court Receives Disposition Error Report Notification (DOJ802), which is used by the integration partner to send a disposition error notification to the trial court.

Error Handling

If the DOJ does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

- A single exchange message is sent for each initial or subsequent disposition notification request.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. The only allowable response to this exchange is an error message. The error response message must be sent as a separate message using the error format defined in this exchange.
