Court Receives Probation Violations Update Notification (DSP821)

Exchange Description

Trial courts use this NIEM-based data exchange to receive notice of a probation violation from an integration partner. The confirmation notification information in this data exchange is sent to the same integration partner that originated the case initiation request. The integration partner may wish to use this data exchange to notify the courts of probation conditions that have been violated.

- The request message contains the probation violations information (e.g., CCMS case number, probation conditions, violation description, and filing document) sent by the integration partner to the court.
- The success response message contains the probation violations information delivery confirmation message with the request data echoed back to the integration partner (e.g., CCMS case number, probation conditions, violation description, and filing document).

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- Court Sends Probation Violations Update Confirmation Notification (DSP923), which confirms that the initial request successfully passed the clerk review and contains the pertinent case information.
- Court Sends Clerk Review Rejection Notification (EFL902), which contains rejection information in response to the court clerk's review of the initial request.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each probation violations update notification.
- This exchange is subject to the clerk review process, which requires that court personnel review the contents of the exchange before it is accepted and added into CCMS. The content of the response message is defined using a different exchange, listed in the Business Response Exchanges section.
