## Court Receives Draft Minute Order Notification (DSP822)

### Exchange Description

Integration partners use this NIEM-based data exchange to send the trial court a set of minute codes to create a draft minute order associated with a future hearing on a case. Specifically, an integration partner can use this data exchange to send Minutes Order Capture System (MOCS) codes for the following:

- Proposed orders on probation violations
- Probation recommendations

The notification message from the integration partner contains the draft minute order information (e.g., event information, MOCS code and text).

The response message contains the draft minute order response, including the success code and success description.

### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There are no business response exchanges to this exchange.

### Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner receives an error message with an error code and error reason.
