### Court Sends Order After Hearing Notification (DSP913)

#### Exchange Description

A trial court uses this NIEM-based data exchange to send finalized Order After Hearing (OAH) forms and associated data (Minute Order Codes [MOCS] codes and text) to an integration partner when a family law or juvenile proposed order is finalized and issued either inside or outside the courtroom. This exchange can produce many standardized court forms and orders in PDF format.

The trial court may use this exchange to send:

- Child support orders with or without income withholding orders to the California Department of Child Support Services (DCSS)/Child Support Enforcement
- Paternity judgments and/or child support orders to the local DCSS
- Adoption forms to the child welfare system (CWS)
- Orders after courtroom or ex parte hearings

The notification message contains OAH information (e.g., OAH form number, form data, PDF versions of forms and orders) sent by the trial court to an integration partner.

No response message is sent by the integration partner upon successful receipt of the notification message. Successful delivery of the message is assumed unless an error in delivery or receipt and processing by the integration partner occurs.
