Court Sends Restraining Order Issuance/Cancel/Update Notification (DSP917)

Exchange Description

A trial court uses this NIEM-based data exchange to send restraining order issuances, modifications, and removals to an integration partner when a restraining order is issued, modified, or removed by the trial court.

The notification message sent by the trial court to the integration partner contains restraining order information (e.g., protected party, restrained party, restraining order type).

Upon successful receipt and acceptance of the notification, the integration partner sends the trial court a response message indicating that the message has been received or rejected. When the integration partner is the California Department of Justice (DOJ), restraining order information is returned (e.g., restraining order file control number) when the notification is accepted.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There is no business response to this exchange.

Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Sends Restraining Order POS Issuance/Cancel Notification (INI918), which is used by the trial court to send a restraining order proof of service (POS) or cancellation of a previously submitted restraining order POS to the California Department of Justice.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each restraining order issuance/cancellation/update notification.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. The response message is defined in the current exchange.
