## Court Sends Credit Card Payment Authorization (FCC905)

### Exchange Description

A trial court uses this California judicial branch XML-based data exchange to send a credit card payment authorization request to an integration partner when a credit card payment is processed by the trial court.

- The notification message sent by the trial court to a credit card processing vendor contains the credit card authorization information (e.g., credit card number, payer, and amount charged).
- The response message sent by the credit card processing vendor to the trial court indicating whether the credit card payment authorization has been accepted or rejected contains the credit card authorization request response (e.g., accept/reject indicator and authorization number).

### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange.

- There is no business response to this exchange.

### Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the incoming authorization message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.
