Court Receives Case Initiation Filing—Family Law (Marriage/Domestic Partnership with/without Child) (INI807)

Exchange Description

A trial court uses this California judicial branch XML schema-based data exchange to receive case initiation filing documents from an integration partner to initiate a family law case pertaining to a marriage or to a domestic partnership with or without children, for the following case types:

- Dissolution of Marriage with Minor Children
- Dissolution of Domestic Partnership with Minor Children
- Legal Separation of Marriage with Minor Children
- Legal Separation of Domestic Partnership with Minor Children
- Nullity of Marriage with Minor Children
- Nullity of Domestic Partnership with Minor Children
- Dissolution of Marriage without Children
- Dissolution of Domestic Partnership without Children
- Legal Separation of Marriage without Children
- Legal Separation of Domestic Partnership without Children
- Nullity of Marriage without Children
- Nullity of Domestic Partnership without Children
- Summary Dissolution of Marriage

Integration partners may, for example, use this data exchange to file on behalf of their clients to:

- Dissolve a marriage
- Annul a marriage

The request message sent by the integration partner to the trial court contains the family law case initiation filing information (e.g., participants, case type, attachment, and filing document).

The response message from the trial court to the integration partner contains delivery confirmation data with status information (e.g., “Received”), along with the contents of the original request message sent from the integration partner to the trial court.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are any preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Subsequent Case Filing (INI816), which is used by the integration partner to submit all additional case filing information to the trial court.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange, as follows:

- Court Sends Case Initiation Filing—Family Law (Marriage/Domestic Partnership with/without Child) Confirmation Notification (INI926), which confirms that the initial filing successfully passed the clerk review process and contains the new case filing information.
- Court Sends Clerk Review Rejection Notification (EFL902), which contains rejection information in response to the court clerk's review of the initial filing.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each family law case filing initiation request.
- The content of the business response to this exchange is defined in a different exchange listed above in the Business Response Exchanges section.
- This exchange is subject to the court clerk review process, which requires that court personnel review the contents of the exchange before it is accepted and added to CCMS.
