Court Receives Case Initiation Filing—Family Law Registration of Judgment or Order (INI812)

Exchange Description

A trial court uses this California judicial branch XML-based data exchange to receive from an integration partner the registration of an out-of-state judgment or order and to initiate a family law case for the following case types:

- Registration of Out-of-State Custody Order
- Registration of Out-of-State Judgment
- Registration of Out-of-State Restraining Order
- Registration of Out-of-State Support Order
- Statement for Registration of California Support Order
- Juvenile Custody Order

The request message sent by the integration partner to the trial court contains the case initiation filing information (e.g., participants, judgment or order data, and filing documents).

The response message sent by the trial court to the integration partner contains delivery confirmation data with status information (e.g., “Received”), along with contents of the original request message sent by the integration partner to the trial court.

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are any preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Subsequent Case Filing (INI816), which is used by the integration partner to submit all additional case filing information to the trial court.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange, as follows:

- Court Sends Case Initiation Filing—Family Law (Registration of Judgment or Order) Confirmation Notification (INI931), which confirms that the initial filing successfully passed the clerk review (CR) process and contains the new case filing information.
- Court Sends Clerk Review Rejection Notification (EFL902), which contains rejection information in response to the court clerk's review of the initial filing.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each registration of judgment or order family law case filing initiation request.
- The content of the business response to this exchange is defined in a different exchange listed above in the Business Response Exchanges section.
- This exchange is subject to the court clerk review process, which requires that court personnel review the contents of the exchange before it is accepted and added to CCMS.
