Court Sends Case Initiation Filing—Small Claims Confirmation Notification (INI923)

Exchange Description

A trial court uses this California judicial branch XML schema-based data exchange to send an acceptance response to the same integration partner that originated the case initiation request for a small claims case filing.

The confirmation notification message sent by the trial court to the integration partner contains the new small claims case notification information (e.g., CCMS case number, participant, and small claims specific case information).

No response message is sent by the integration partner upon successful receipt of the notification message. Successful delivery of the notification message is assumed unless an error in delivery or processing by the integration partner occurs.

Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange, as follows:

- There is no business response to this exchange.

Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the incoming notification message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

PROBABLE INTERESTED INTEGRATION PARTNERS

- Electronic filing service provider

RELATED EXCHANGES

Related data exchanges are any preceding or subsequent data exchanges that may be used by an integration partner as part of the overall business process related to this exchange.

- Court Receives Case Initiation Filing—Small Claims (INI804), which is used by the trial court to receive a case initiation filing document from an integration partner to initiate a small claims case.
- Court Sends Case Participant Demographic Information Notification (PF901), which is used to send updated participant demographic information if participant demographic information is updated by this exchange (INI923).
- Court Sends E-Service Notification (FN903), which is used if the participant's preferred mode of delivery is "Web Service Address" and "Receives Notice."

Additional Information

- A single exchange message is sent for each small claims case initiation filing confirmation notification.
- The response to this exchange message only occurs after receipt and processing by the integration partner. The only allowable response to this exchange is an error message. The error response message must be sent as a separate message using the error format defined in this exchange.
