## Court Receives Family Unit Update Request (PF807)

### Exchange Description

A trial court uses this California judicial branch XML schema-based data exchange to receive a request from an integration partner to update information about an existing family unit in the CCMS, either to add or remove family members or to add, modify, or remove relationships for existing family members.

The request message sent by the integration partner to the trial court contains the family unit update information (e.g., family unit identifier, family member information, and qualifier).

The response message from the trial court contains delivery confirmation data with status information ('Received') and the contents of the original request message sent by the integration partner to the trial court.

### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange, as follows:

- Court Sends Family Unit Update Confirmation Notification (PF908), which confirms that the update request successfully passed the clerk review and contains the pertinent update information.
- Court Sends Clerk Review Rejection Notification (EFL902), which contains rejection information in response to the court clerk's review of the family unit update request.

### RELATED EXCHANGES

## **Error Handling**

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

- A single exchange message is sent for each family unit update request.
- The business response message is defined using a different exchange, listed above in the Business Response Exchanges section.
- This exchange is subject to the court clerk review (CR) process, which requires that court personnel review the contents of the exchange before it is accepted and added to CCMS.
