### Court Sends Case Participant Demographic Information Notification (PF901)

#### Exchange Description

A trial court uses this NIEM-based data exchange to send case participant demographic information to an integration partner. A trial court may use this exchange to add, update, or remove the following demographic data for a case participant:

- Doing Business As (DBA) or Also Known As (AKA) name
- Mailing address
- Phone number
- Family relationship

The notification message sent by the trial court to the integration partner contains the demographic information of a case participant (e.g., CCMS case number, participant name, and participant address).

No response message is sent by the integration partner upon successful receipt of the notification message. Successful delivery of the notification message is assumed unless an error in delivery or processing by the integration partner occurs.

#### Business Response Exchanges

The business response refers to any subsequent exchanges that may occur as a direct result of this exchange, as follows:

- There is no business response to this exchange.

#### Error Handling

If the integration partner does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the trial court will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.
