Court Receives Disbursement Update Notification (PHX802)

Exchange Description

A trial court uses this California judicial branch XML schema-based data exchange to receive a disbursement update notification from an integration partner.

An integration partner may use this data exchange to notify the trial court that:

- Disbursement checks have been printed and mailed.
- Disbursement check requests have been rejected.
- Disbursement checks have cleared.
- Disbursement checks have been returned un-cashed (e.g., incorrect address, lost check).
- Disbursement checks have been voided.

The notification message sent by the integration partner to the trial court contains the disbursement update information (e.g., CCMS case number, participant, amount, and disbursement status).

No response message is sent by the trial court upon successful receipt of the notification message. Successful delivery of the notification message is assumed unless an error in delivery or processing by the integration partner occurs.

Error Handling

If the trial court does not successfully receive and process the incoming message, the integration partner will receive an error message with an error code and error reason.

Additional Information

- This is a batch exchange containing multiple case disbursement updates.
- The response to this message only occurs after receipt and processing by the trial court. The only allowable response to this exchange is an error message. The error response message must be sent as a separate message using the error format defined in this exchange.
