2022 Transfer of Knowledge Skills Building One-Day Training ©

The Judicial Council of California, Operations and Programs Division, Center for Families, Children & the Courts, Access to Visitation (AV) Grant Program, in collaboration with the California Association of Supervised Visitation Service Providers (CASVSP) is pleased to announce its **new training** implemented in 2021 to assist providers who have completed the Standard 5.20 and Family Code section 3200.5 Training. This one-day training will apply principles learned in the Standard 5.20 training to real practice situations for professional providers of supervised visitation and exchange services. The **Transfer of Knowledge and Skills One-Day Training** is for those seeking direct hands-on technical assistance guidance relating to challenging program practices and issues in working with parents and children and direction for development of effective policies and procedures.

In the Standard 5.20, attendees were provided the basic nuts and bolts knowledge for understanding the legislative intent and proposed best practice considerations regarding the duties and obligations for the provider as set forth by the standards of practice. This was an introduction into the state standards of practices with **Knowledge** defined as the fact or condition of being aware of something. This training is a **skills-based** training—specific, hands-on approach with strategies for improving the providers capacity and performance in addressing program issues for critical and immediate decision-making. This is practical application training for the professional provider post completion of Standard 5.20.
