**DECLARATION OF KERMIT ALEXANDER IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO
INTERVENE**

I, KERMIT ALEXANDER, declare:

1. I am the Proponent of Proposition 66, the Death Penalty Reform and Savings Act, which appeared on the ballot and was approved by California voters at the November 8, 2016 election. I agreed to serve as Proponent of Proposition 66, as a relative of four capital murder victims, to support other families victimized by the loss of loved ones at the hands of persons convicted of capital murders, and as a longtime advocate of enforcement of California's death penalty statute.

2. Through the drafting, submission to the Attorney General for title and summary, qualification for the ballot by obtaining sufficient signatures of California voters, and the campaign to enact Proposition 66, I was a member of the Yes On Proposition 66 Committee, and the Yes On Proposition 66 Committee worked closely with me in his performance of the duties of a proponent of a statewide ballot measure. I spoke at public forums and events on behalf of the Yes On Proposition 66 Committee and in support of Proposition 66.

3. I authorize the Yes On Proposition 66 Committee to represent me in my capacity of Proponent of the measure in seeking to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding to defend Proposition 66. Proposition 66, section 21, authorizes me as the Proponent to intervene in litigation to defend Proposition 66, whether in support of the Governor's and the Attorney General's defense of the measure or alone, if they do not defend the measure.

4. My interests in authorizing the Yes on Proposition 66 Committee to represent me are to assure the best defense of the measure.

The foregoing is true and correct and of my personal knowledge. If called as a witness I could and would testify competently thereto. Executed under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California at RIVERSIDE, California this 2ND day of January, 2017.
