
I, McGREGOR W. SCOTT, declare:

1. I am the Chairman of CALIFORNIANS TO MEND, NOT END, THE DEATH PENALTY - NO ON PROP 62, YES ON PROP 66 ("Yes On Proposition 66 Committee"), a California non-profit association tax exempt under Section 501c4 of the Internal Revenue Code and section 23701f of the California Rev. & Taxation Code. The Yes on Proposition 66 Committee is a registered California recipient campaign committee organized under the Political Reform Act of 1974, as amended, Gov. Code section 81000 et seq., which was primarily-formed to support the qualification and passage of Proposition 66 at the November 8, 2016 election.

2. KERMIT ALEXANDER, the proponent of Proposition 66 under Elec. Code section 342, was a member of the Yes On Proposition 66 Committee, and the Yes On Proposition 66 Committee worked closely with the proponent in his performance of the duties of a proponent of a statewide ballot measure as set forth in sections 342, 9001 (submission of the proposed measure for title and summary), 9008-9009, 9020 (arrange for the printing and circulation of initiative petitions for signature by voters), 9030 and 9032 (arrange for the filing of signed initiative petitions), and 9065, 9067 (sign ballot arguments and authorize others to sign ballot arguments regarding the measure). Mr. Alexander spoke at public forums and events on behalf of the Yes On Proposition 66 Committee and in support of Proposition 66.

3. Mr. Alexander has authorized the Yes On Proposition 66 to represent him in his capacity of Proponent of the measure in seeking to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding to defend Proposition 66, as he is authorized to do by section 21 of the Proposition 66. His interests in doing so are to assure the best defense of the measure.
