



BlueJeans Events Instructions for Attendees

The Court of Appeal, Third Appellate District, will conduct its oral argument calendar by video conference using the BlueJeans Events application (BlueJeans Events). The public is invited to join the proceedings by telephone or online through a web browser or the BlueJeans Events app (recommended).

There will be separate BlueJeans Events sessions for the morning and afternoon calendars. Connection information for each session will be posted on the Third District's website (<https://www.courts.ca.gov/3dca.htm>). Event links and dial-in codes will be different for each session; be sure to use the correct link and/or code for the session you want to join.

Public attendees will be able to watch and/or listen but will not be seen or heard. Chat, Q&A, polling, and other features of the webinar software will be turned off. As a member of the public, you do not need to share your full name or email address to attend. Although the software requires something in the "Name" field before joining, you may use your name, initials, or first name only.

Throughout the oral argument, you will be able to see the three justices on the panel as well as the participants for each side of the case, if they have web cameras. Each participant's name should be displayed at the bottom of their video stream. If the participant does not have a webcam, then a blank square will pop up on your screen when that person is speaking on the phone.

During the session, the Court may hear more than one case. When that happens, there will be a slight delay between cases, and the bailiff will display a notice on the screen while the justices and participants for the next case join the session.
