ELECTRONIC DEVICES

ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE COURTROOM EXCEPT:

- LAPTOPS OR TABLETS USED BY COUNSEL AS AN AID IN PRESENTING ORAL ARGUMENT. THESE DEVICES CANNOT BE USED TO DISPLAY DEMONSTRATIVE EVIDENCE OR FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE.
- ASSISTED LISTENING DEVICES.

**ALL PERMITTED DEVICES MUST BE SILENCED AND
PLACED ON “AIRPLANE MODE” PRIOR TO ENTERING THE COURTROOM.**

No audio or video recording or taking of photographs is allowed unless approved pursuant to California rules of court, RULE 1.150.

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RESTRICTIONS WILL RESULT
IN REMOVAL FROM THE COURTROOM.**
