

This letter specifies the issues on which I expect to focus during oral argument in *People v. Silveria & Travis*, case No. S062417, scheduled for argument on May 20, 2020, in San Francisco. As respondent's counsel, I intend to address any issues raised in appellant's argument. Additionally, I intend to focus on the denial of appellants' motion to sever at the penalty retrial. As captioned by appellant Silveria:

XI. The trial judge violated appellant's right to an individualized sentencing determination, a fair trial, and a reliable sentence when he denied appellant's motion to sever his second penalty trial from that of co-appellant Travis.

And as captioned by appellant Travis:

V. The trial court erred in rejoining defendants Travis and Silveria for a penalty retrial with a single jury, after separate juries had been unable to agree on penalty verdicts for either defendant.

In addition, I will be prepared to address any matter of interest to the Court.
