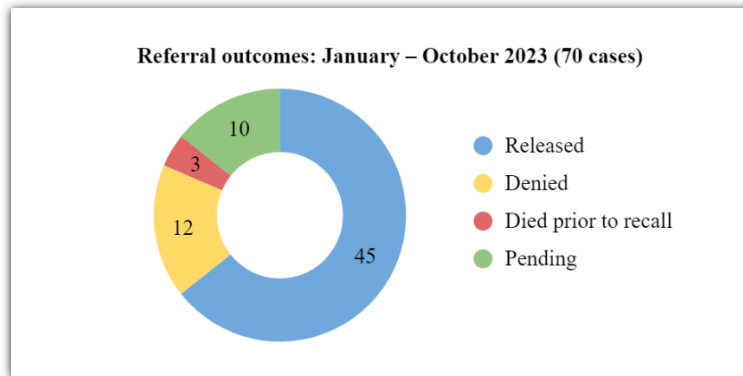


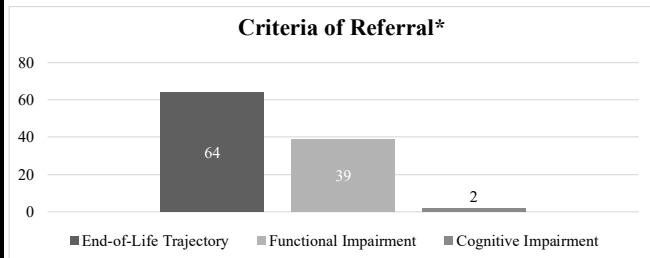
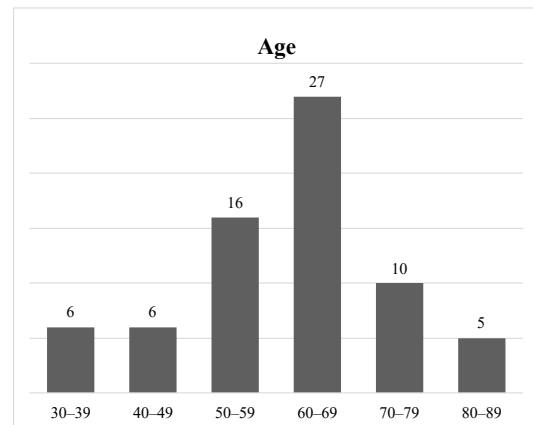
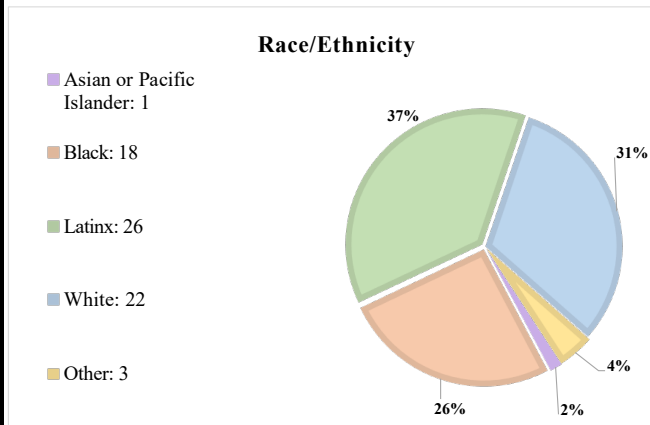


JUDICIAL COUNCIL of CALIFORNIA

Penal Code section [1172.2](#) authorizes the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) to recommend recall and resentencing when an incarcerated person has a serious illness with an end-of-life trajectory or is medically incapacitated. This report fulfills the Judicial Council’s mandate to publicly release demographic and referral criteria data. Note: this report only includes cases referred to the courts and does not reflect cases denied referral by CDCR due to lack of postrelease plans.
