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| 1 | Attachment 2 - Standard Agreement, Exhibit B, Sections 5.2 and 5.3 | Sections 5.2 and 5.3 of Exhibit B show the Performance Criteria Phase and Pre-GMP Phase listed as NIC (Not In Contract), is this information correct? | <p>The Pre-GMP Phase should not have been listed as NIC, and only a portion of the Performance Criteria Phase should have been listed as NIC.</p> <p>Please see Addendum 1 which has revised Sections 5.2 and 5.3 of Attachment 2, Exhibit B.</p> |
| 2 | RFP Section 6.4.1.1, Page 8 of 10. | With regards to the weighting percentage for various positions, Project Engineer is weighted at 25%, which is higher than Project Manager and Construction Manager (both at 20%). Why is the Project Engineer weighted more heavily than the other roles? | The Project Manager (Pre-Construction) and Construction Manager roles combined weigh more than the Project Engineer does. The Project Manager role and the Construction Manager role add up to 40% in aggregate, which the JCC believes to be an appropriate aggregate weight for those roles. |
| 3 | RFP Section 5.1.2, Page 6 of 10. | During the pre-proposal conference, JCC re-iterated that proposers need not demonstrate DVBE participation in the proposal phase. Please confirm that proposals need not include Attachment 10, DVBE Participation Form. | That is correct, proposals need not include Attachment 10, DVBE Participation Form. However, the Judicial Council has a DVBE participation goal of a minimum of three percent (3%) for the awarded contract, and the form will be required to be submitted by the firm selected for services. |
