
Juvenile Dependency Court Process



or 60 days after the date of protective custody, whichever is first (§361.49)

- Disposition Hearing the hearing at which the court declares dependency and orders the plan for the family; can be held the same day as Jurisdiction or either 10 court days later (if the child has been detained) or 30 calendar days later (if the child has not been detained)
- §366.21(e) hearing: six months from disposition
- 10 §366.21(f) hearing: twelve months from date entered foster care
- §366.22 hearing: eighteen months from date of protective custody
- 12 §366.25 Hearing: twenty-four months from date of protective custody
- §366.26 Hearing: the hearing at which the court chooses the permanent plan for the child
