





Juvenile Drug Treatment Court Juvenile Mental health Treatment Court(CITA)

Dual Diagnosed Youth - Substance abuse disorders - Counseling - Detox or residential - Mental Health diagnosis - Assessment - Hospitalization - Medication







Eligibility Criteria
 Legal Criteria At least 14 Sustained 602 petition (usually not 707b,273.5 or 243e) Usually not drug sales case
■ No felony sex offense history
 Clinical Criteria A pattern of substance use that appears to be contributing to delinquency and/or
 A diagnosis of a mental health disorder (brain condition with a genetic component) Major depression
Bipolar disorder Schizophrenia Severe mood or anxiety disorder
ADHD

- 57 INTERVIEWED - 27 ACCEPTED Not accepted reasons: -Not interested -Lack of Family support -Received new petition -Higher need level -Left county	

Process

Probation interview

- Suitability
- Juvenile's and family interest
- Releases

Clinical Assessment

- Referral to Chemical Dependency Counselor
- Treatment recommendation







Four Phases

- Phase one—weeklyPhase two---bi-weeklyPhase three—tri-weeklyPhase four--monthly
- Graduation

Results 2015

- 31 juveniles19 successful graduates5 re-arrests
