3. 6.1. f. **vi.** **The Awarded Contractor under this IFB shall comply with the registration and compliance monitoring provisions of Labor Code section 1771.4, including furnishing its CPRs to the Labor Commissioner of California and complying with any applicable enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. Labor Code section 1771.1(a) states the following:**

“A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.”

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Any Bidder shall, and shall ensure that all “subcontractors” (as defined by Labor Code section 1722.1), comply with Labor Code section 1725.5, including without limitation the registration requirements with the Department of Industrial Relations that are set forth in Labor Code section 1725.5. All Proposers must represent to the Judicial Council that all “subcontractors” (as defined by Labor Code section 1722.1) are registered pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. Any Proposer acknowledges that, for purposes of Labor Code section 1725.5, this work is a public work to which Labor Code section 1771 applies.

This IFB and any resulting agreement of this IFB are subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. Any awarded Proposer shall post job site notices, as prescribed by regulation. Any awarded Contractor shall comply with all requirements of Labor Code section 1771.4, except the possible requirements that are exempted by the Labor Commissioner for the any of the work that will be performed under this IFB.

4. 6.1.f.vii. Prior to commencing any work on this High Density File System Project, the awarded Proposer shall furnish the following surety bonds issued by a California admitted surety insurer as follows: a. Performance Bond: A bond in an amount at least equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the complete quote (cost and non-cost) for the High Density File System as security for faithful performance of the awarded contract for this IFB; b. Payment Bond: A bond in an amount at least equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the complete quote for the High Density File System for payment of persons performing labor and/or furnishing materials in connection with the awarded contract for this IFB.
5. 6.1.f.viii. Each Proposer must submit a copy of their contractor license(s) they have on file.
6. 6.2 Cost Information:
 - ii. The complete cost to install the unit defined in Attachment A. The complete cost to install the unit defined in Attachment A must include the following cost information: The Proposer awarded a contract with this IFB shall pay all workers not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Copies of the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Agreement, as determined by Director of the State of California Department of Industrial Relations, are on file at the Judicial Council’s principal office.
