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## Summary

In early 2020, the Judicial Branch Statistical Information System (JBSIS) Subcommittee undertook a project to review all the data elements collected in JBSIS to determine whether improvements could be made to increase the reliability and accuracy of JBSIS data reporting. The subcommittee's work resulted in a recommendation to adopt a new standard for JBSIS data reporting (JBSIS 4.0) that established three tiers of data reporting—mandated, supplemental, and local—for each of the JBSIS reports (4A through 13A). JBSIS 4.0 was adopted by the Judicial Council in July 2022 and its expected implementation date is July 1, 2025. As part of the implementation of the 4.0 standards, staff discovered an issue with the 09a Juvenile Dependency report that requires clarification. In addition, since the JBSIS4.0 standards were approved, the CARE Act created a new filing type and reporting requirements that need to be integrated into the 4.0 reporting. Staff are seeking subcommittee approval for these updates to the 4.0 reporting standards.

### **9A Juvenile Dependency**

The mandated (Statewide reporting) matrix for this report type was approved by the JBSIS Subcommittee on September 21, 2020 (see attached 4.0 09a Juvenile Dependency State Matrix A). The approved matrix added new workload and events rows that are not present in the state report for other casetypes. Staff reviewed the meeting audio for all subcommittee meetings during the review period to determine whether there was a reason that workload and hearings were included in the state matrix for this case type but was unable to locate the audio for the September 21, 2020 meeting. Absent information to the contrary, staff propose moving the hearings and events data to the local report to be consistent with how these matters are reported for other casetypes. The staff proposal is in the attached 4.0 09a Juvenile Dependency State Matrix B.

## **CARE Act Implementation**

In addition to creating a new case type, the CARE Act creates new reporting requirements on the 10A Mental Health report for events and workload during the life of a case. Those events and workload have been mapped to JBSIS and new data elements have been proposed where none exist. To streamline data reporting, staff propose moving some JBSIS rows that had been previously designated for the local report back to the statewide report. Without moving those rows, some event and workload data would be reported on the statewide report and others on the local report. The 10a Mental Health State Report, as currently configured, is attached as "4.0 10a Mental Health State Matrix A" and the proposed report is attached as "4.0 Mental Health State Matrix B."

#### Recommendation

Staff recommend approval of proposed 4.0 State, Supplemental, and Local Matrix B for 09a Juvenile Dependency and 10a Mental Health as those reports are consistent with the decision rules made for 4.0 data reporting and best implement the CARE Act data reporting requirements.
