a) Notification of Reduced or Dismissed Convictions for Probation Transfer Cases
Requires notification of reduction of felonies to misdemeanors and dismissals of
convictions in probation transfer cases between receiving courts and transferring courts.

b) Recognition of Tribal Court Orders Relating to the Division of Marital Assets

Ensures that valid divorce or dissolution judgments issued by tribal courts that include division of pension or other deferred compensation assets are effective and, in particular, are recognized as meeting the requirements of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA) (Public Law 93-406; 88 Stat. 829) and other similar statutes that restrict the transfer or division of such assets.

c) Video Appearances in All Civil Actions and Proceedings

Provides statutory authority for courts to permit video appearances in any civil actions or proceedings including trials and evidentiary hearings.
