#### **OPEN SESSION OF MEETING**

#### Call to Order, Opening Remarks, and Roll Call

OPEN SESSION - ACTION ITEMS (ITEMS 1-11)

### Action Item 1 – List A – Emergency Facility Modification Funding (Priority 1)

Summary: Ratify emergency facility modifications from List A.

Action: Reviewed and approved 51 projects for a total of \$1,655,511 to be paid from Facility Modification program funds previously encumbered. (Motion: Rockwell; Second: Vallarta)

## Action Item 2 – List B – Facility Modifications Less than \$100K (Priority 2)

Summary: Ratify facility modifications less than \$100K from List B.

Action: Reviewed and approved 123 projects for a total of \$1,008,779 to be paid from Facility Modification program funds previously encumbered. Line number 81 (FM-0063375) was deferred by the committee until the next TCFMAC meeting scheduled March 8, 2019. (Motion: Vallarta; Second: Highberger)

## Action Item 3 – List C – Cost Increases Over \$50K

Summary: Ratify facility modifications requiring cost increases over \$50K from List C.

Action: Reviewed and approved 2 projects for a total cost increase to the Facility Modifications Program budget of \$490,455. (Motion: Highberger; Second: Romero-Soles)

## Action Item 4 – List D – Facility Modifications Over \$100K

**Summary**: Review recommended facility modifications over \$100K from List D and P3 projects.

Action: Reviewed and approved 10 facility modification projects for a total cost to the Facility Modification Program Budget of \$6,257,584—of which \$5M will be funded from DMF-II funds and the balance from FM funds—as previously authorized by the committee in December 2018. (Motion: Highberger; Second: Rockwell)
