Protocol for Registering Tribal Court Protective Orders with the Superior Court

- 1. Tribal Court protection orders shall be registered with the Superior Court in order to assure prompt entry into CLETS to ensure victim safety.
- 2. The Tribal Court will register its orders in the following manner:
 - a. The Tribal Court issues protective order. (Including firearm prohibition; using Project Passport cover sheet). Have **DV-600 form** in court for Petitioner to sign: <u>http://www.courtinfo.ca.gov/forms/fillable/dv600.pdf</u>
 - b. **Call** the contact person at the Superior Court to inform them that the order registration is pending (*see following page for contact information*).
 - c. **Fax** a certified copy of the Tribal Court order, along with a copy of the signed Form DV-600, to the Superior Court office.
 - d. Promptly follow up by **mail** with a certified copy of the Tribal Court order and original DV-600 form to the Superior Court office.
- 3. Superior Court will open a file and assign a case number.
- 4. Superior Court will **fax** a copy of the order to the Tribal Court, with the case number and either **mail** certified originals back to the Tribal Court or put originals in Tribe's box at the courthouse, as agreed.
- 5. Superior Court will deliver order to Sheriff's office for entry into CLETS. (Hoopa will bring to Substation.)
- 6. Tribal Court will inform Petitioner of service requirements provide information cover sheet from Sheriff's Office if requested from Sheriff's Office.
- 7. Petitioner files original Proof of Service in Superior Court, gives a copy to Tribal Court.
- 8. Petitioner [or Tribal Court] provides Sheriff copy of information cover sheet and Proof of Service (can fax) for enforcement. *Note law enforcement cannot enforce until the restrained party is served.*
