Summary of Cases Accepted During the Week of January 23, 2006

#06-08 In re Bay-Delta Programmatic Environmental Impact Report Coordinated Proceedings, S138974 (Laub v. Schwarzenneger), S138975 (Regional Council of Rural Counties v. State of California). (C044267, C044577; 133 Cal.App.4th 154; Sacramento County Superior Court; JCCP No. 4152.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal reversed and affirmed judgments in actions for writ of administrative mandate. This case includes the following issue: Did the final programmatic environmental impact report for the multi-agency, multi-jurisdictional CALFED Bay-Delta Program adequately address alternatives to diverting Bay-Delta water to southern California and the potential environmental impacts of diverting water to be purchased from as yet unidentified sources?
